Feedback Report (A.Y. 2020 – 21)

Feedback on teaching – learning was collected from the students across all the programs, subjects and years.

Students were asked to give feedback, on the following parameters:

1. Communication skills & Self confidence
2. Quality of teaching
3. Refers to history and present development
4. Resourcefulness and readiness
5. Punctuality and regularity
6. Delivery of structured lecture
7. Completion of syllabus in time

Teaching – learning process was rated on a scale of “**excellent; very good; good; satisfactory; and unsatisfactory**”.

Students' feedback on teaching and learning was conducted in December 2021 by circulating Google Forms, observations of which are as follows:

No. of responses received – 16 students

1. It was found that most of the students have given a rating of “**excellent**” and “**very good**” to their subject teachers on all the parameters mentioned above.
2. Students have expressed their appreciation over organization and management of the lectures and overall teaching quality
3. It was suggested in the feedback form that the digital library should be provided

No. of responses received - 32 students

1. All the subject teachers have received the highest rating of **“excellent”** on all the parameters mentioned above, by most of the students.
2. Students have appreciated efforts put in by teachers in teaching – learning process, communication with the students and problem solving, overall quality of teaching, among other things
3. Students have expressed concerns about providing reasonable time for completion of submissions and greater use of PPTs for better understanding

3. In the feedback form, a suggestion has been made that more practical aspect should be brought to the lectures, greater



interactions through quiz and discussion as well as use of audio – visual content in the lectures
