ELIGIBILITY FOR ENROLMENT



1. All the *bonafide* students of our College [Except the students enrolled for Diploma and PG in Law (LL.M.)] are eligible for appearing for NSS interview *if*—
 - The student has passed or failed with ATKT in last year's exam of the University.
 - No student failed in the FINAL year exam of the University shall appear for NSS interview even if the student has completed one year of NSS and has submitted revaluation form in current academic year.



1. All the NSS Volunteers shall be selected through interview and active participation in past years' NSS activities.
2. NSS interview is mandatory for all students interested to join as a volunteer in first or second year of NSS. The students who have completed one year of NSS shall also appear for NSS interview.
3. Students shall submit all required documents (Separate notice will be issued in this regard as per the SPPU requirement) whenever required.
