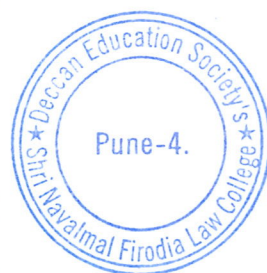

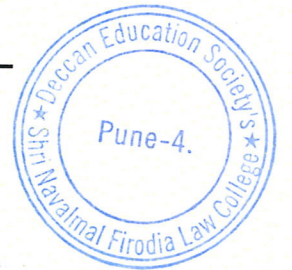

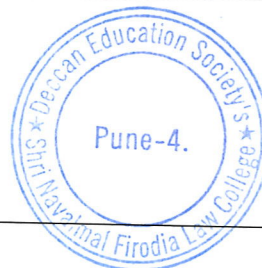
evolution, and significance of the Constitution, discuss landmark judgments, amendments, and their impact on society and to encourage law students and young advocates to engage with constitutional principles.

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For this Symposium, an overwhelming response was noted. A large number of student and practicing advocates were participated.

The symposium started with the lamp lighting & Pratima Pujan in the hands of Chief Guest and dignitaries on the dais, and then after Miss Navishka Boyawar, a student from BA.LL.B. first year, gave the introduction of the program and requested Adv. Tejas Dandagaval, member of Adhivakta Parishad, to give the introduction of Adhivakta Parishad. Adv. Vedika Baligar gave a brief introduction of Chief Guest Adv. Ashok Plande, Vice Chairman, GB & Council DES, and Chairman, CDC DES SNFLC, and requested Adv. Muralidhar Kachare, President, Adhivakta Parishad, Pune, to felicitate Chief Guest. She also gave an introduction of guest speaker Adv. Akhil Kachare and requested Prin. Dr. Sunita Adhav madam to felicitate.

This Symposium was divided into six presentation including keynote address of chief Guest. The first presentation was on the topic 'Constitutional Mechanism to Empower Youth in India' where Samiksha Geradi Student of BA. LLB.- IV express her thoughts and highlight from the enforcement of Constitution how constitutional mechanism playing role to empower youth in India effectively.

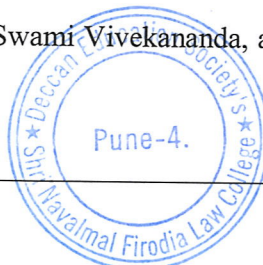
The second presentation was on the topic 'Youth Rights and Democracy' where Miss. Pooja Khunte Student of LLB first year narrate youth are backbone of India's democracy and active participation leads to a stronger democracy.

The third presentation was on the topic 'Role of the Indian Constitution in Empowering Youth,' delivered by Miss Tanishka Chondkar, a fifth-year BA.LLB. student, who stated that the Indian Constitution is not just a legal framework but a moral compass that empowers the youth to dream, aspire, and achieve. It provides them with rights, protects their interests, and enables them to contribute to the nation's progress.

The fourth presentation was on the topic '75 Years Journey of the Indian Constitution and Way Forward,' where Mr. Ajinkya Gosavi, a student of LL.B. second year, narrated the 75-year journey of the Indian Constitution and stated in the way forward he opined that reforms in judicial efficiency, electoral transparency, reservation policies, and governance accountability are essential.

The fifth presentation was on the topic 'Swami Vivekanand and the Indian Constitution,' where Mr. Radheya, a student of LL.B. second year, stated Swami Vivekananda, a spiritual

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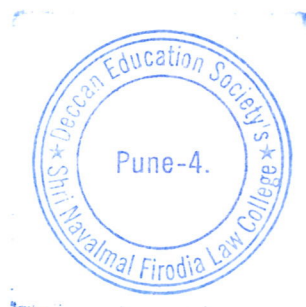
leader and social reformer, played a crucial role in shaping modern Indian thought. His ideals of justice, equality, liberty, and nationalism align closely with the core principles of the Indian Constitution.

Lastly, the keynote address was delivered by Adv. Akhil Kachare, guest speaker on the topic 'Constitution of India and Youth,' where he stated that the Constitution of India empowers youth by granting fundamental rights like equality, freedom of speech, and education. It ensures political participation by allowing voting at 18 years and encourages youth engagement in governance. The Right to Education (Article 21A) and Directive Principles promote youth welfare, skill development, and employment. However, challenges like unemployment, political apathy, and social inequality persist. Further, he appeals to the student; they must uphold constitutional values, participate in democracy, and drive social change. As future leaders, they play a crucial role in building a progressive, just, and inclusive India, as envisioned by the Constitution.

Finally, the program was concluded by the vote of thanks delivered by Asst. Prof. Prithviraj Chavan and the Preamble Recitation.
