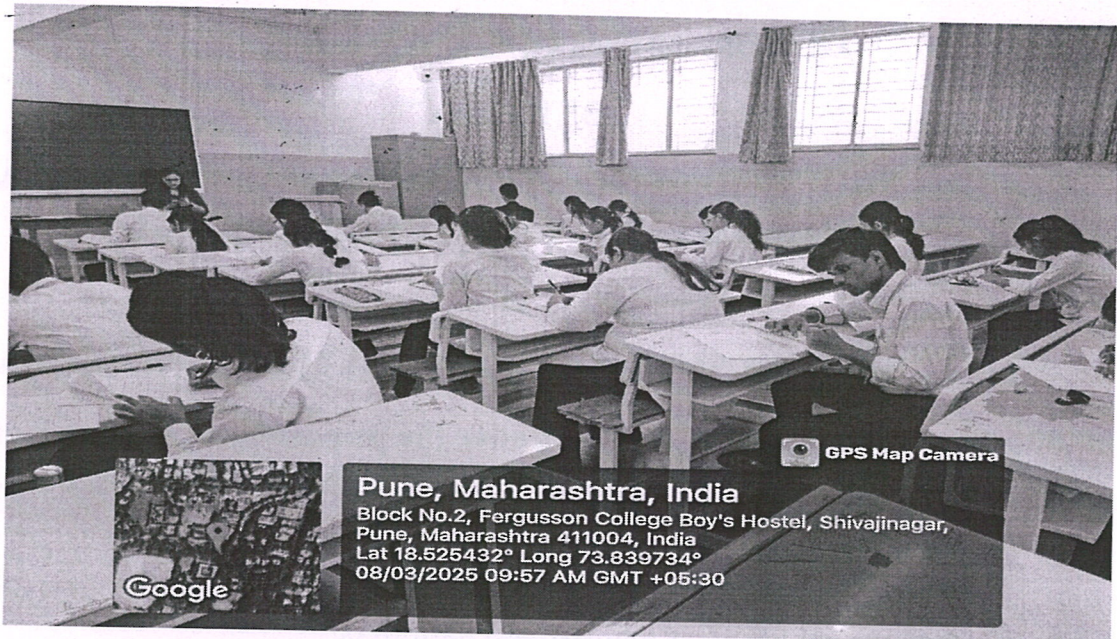
1. Aim & Objectives:

2. Seminar

Report on the Successful Conduct of the Internship Test for NTC.

The Internship Test for NTC was successfully conducted at the campus of DES SNFLC, with the participation of 27 students. The test aimed to assess students' legal knowledge, writing skills, and awareness of current affairs, serving as a crucial step in the selection process for the internship opportunity.

I. Structure and Execution

The test was designed to evaluate multiple aspects of a student's legal aptitude and communication skills through diverse question formats. It comprised:

1. Fill in the Blanks – To assess fundamental legal knowledge and terminology.
2. Letter Writing – To evaluate formal drafting skills and the ability to communicate effectively in a professional setting.
3. Essay Writing – To test analytical thinking, articulation, and the ability to construct well-reasoned arguments on legal and contemporary issues.
4. Current Affairs – To measure awareness of recent legal and socio-political developments.

Faculty coordinators and student coordinators ensured the smooth execution of the test, from registration to invigilation.

II. Participation and Performance

A total of 27 students participated in the test with enthusiasm and dedication. The responses reflected a strong grasp of legal principles, critical thinking, and structured writing skills. The evaluation panel, comprising faculty members and legal professionals, assessed submissions based on accuracy, coherence, and analytical depth.
