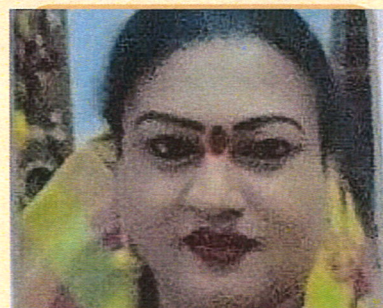

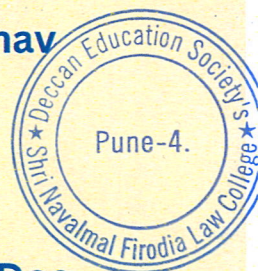

A seminar focusing on Intersectionality of Transgender Rights & Legal Equality was held at DES SNFLC, featuring a distinguished panel of legal experts, activists, and academicians. The event, attended by students, faculty, and legal professionals, aimed to shed light on legal and social inclusion challenges faced by the transgender community.

The program commenced at 10:30 AM morning with Registration and Interactive Session, followed by an Introduction of the Program and Introduction of Adhivakta Parishad. The ceremonial Lighting of the Lamp took place at 11:05 AM, marking the official beginning of the seminar. Dr. Sunita Adhav, Principal of DES SNFLC, delivered the Welcome Address, emphasizing the importance of legal discourse on transgender rights.

The seminar began with insights from representatives of NGOs working for transgender rights.

Further, **Dr. Aishwarya Yadav (Faculty Coordinator)** delved upon the themes of the seminar and **Adv. Sachin Rane** introduced Adhivakta Parishad.

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Technical Session I:

Dr. Umeshchandra More, (District and Sessions Judge, Nashik).

The session focused on legal frameworks and policies influencing transgender rights in India. He also shared his insights on role of Judiciary in recognizing and advancing the rights of transgender community and necessary legal reforms.

Technical session II:

Professor Stéphanie Dijoux (University of Paris, Nanterre) presented an enlightening comparative analysis on Transgender Inclusion and Equality in Germany and France. Her address underscored the differences and similarities in legal recognition and social acceptance of transgender individuals in European nations.

Mayuri Alwekar (President, Maitri Sanghatana, Kolhapur) and Dr. Sanvi Jethwani addressed the audience on the theme of Overcoming Human Rights Barriers for Trans social Inclusion.

A significant highlight of the event was the Unveiling of a Book on Constitutional Law at 12:45 PM, followed by the Introduction of a Research Project on Transgender Rights.

The event was attended by diverse stakeholders including 20 to 30 members from trans community as well.

The seminar concluded with a Vote of Thanks, acknowledging the contributions of esteemed speakers, faculty members, and students who made the event a success.

The event reaffirmed the necessity of legal reforms and active policy interventions to promote social inclusion and justice for the transgender community.

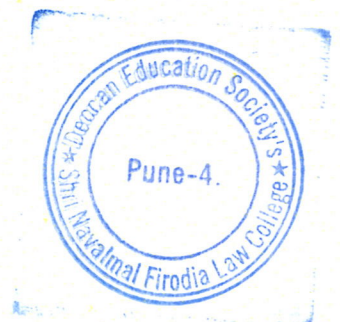
