for women and won cash prize of 5000/- and trophy, third position was held by Sinhagad College of Engineering and received trophy and cash prize of Rs. 3000/-. Modern Law College was appreciated with Consolation prize for their wonderful message to the society.

The student volunteers and coordinators played vital role in curating vibrant atmosphere for participants and the judges. All stakeholders took message provoking their future contribution for the development of the society.
