Report of Regular Activities Conducted Under NSS -2025-26

The activities of NSS are divided in 2 parts i.e regular activities and 7 days NSS Residential Camp. The students worked round the clock to make the events successful one.

The college have actively shown it participation for Social Outreach by conducting various activities under NSS and also participated actively for the said various programme.

1. **Bhakti Yoga Participation : 21st June 2025 :-** Bhakti Yoga 2025 is a premier academic and interdisciplinary outreach program of Savitribai Phule Pune University that seeks to investigate and promote Bhakti Yoga, the spiritual path of devotion, as a comprehensive tool for ethical consciousness, community integration, and personal well-being. It is based on India's Sant Parampara (saint tradition) "strengthening the mind with power of yoga" it combines contemporary wellness techniques of yoga, with mindfulness, and ethical living with traditional devotional knowledge. 2. **Report on Guru Pournima Celebration :- 10 July 2025 :-** DES Shri Navalmal Firodia Law College, Pune celebrated *Guru Pournima* on 10 July 2025 with active participation from teaching and non-teaching staff. The programme

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commenced with a traditional invocation and symbolising the dispelling of ignorance through knowledge. A welcome address was delivered highlighting the relevance of Guru Pournima in the Indian knowledge tradition and its continued significance in legal education. 3. **One-Day Legal Aid Programme Budwadi Village ,Taluka Maval , District Pune.** A One-Day Legal Aid Programme was successfully conducted on **26th July 2025** at **Budwadi village, Taluka Maval, District Pune**, with the objective of creating legal awareness among rural citizens and providing basic legal guidance on issues affecting their daily lives. The programme focused on empowering villagers through knowledge of **property rights, agricultural welfare schemes, women's protection laws, senior citizen rights, and the availability of legal aid mechanisms**. The programme witnesses a drama on domestic violence and role of mediation in settlement of dispute and that eloquently captured the state of women in everyday households and their subjugation in day and age, women are still denied the respect, equal opportunities, and rights that they are due. We learned from the play the value of mediation and how it can be used to resolve disputes. The session was



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concluded with a message to raise public awareness of legal issues, encourage the general public to seek out legal information, and assure them that the institute will assist in fostering this kind of understanding. Also a survey was conducted as to legal aid and issues faced and promoting access to justice and rule of law in rural areas.



4. **Programme at Juvenile Home – Awareness of Rights and Street Play on 12th August 2025 :-** An awareness programme was organized at the Juvenile Home focusing on the **legal rights of children in conflict with law and children in need of care and protection**. The session highlighted provisions of the *Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015*, emphasizing rehabilitation, education, and dignity. A **street play** was performed by students to convey messages related to child rights, reformatory justice, and the importance of social reintegration, which received active engagement from the inmates and staff.

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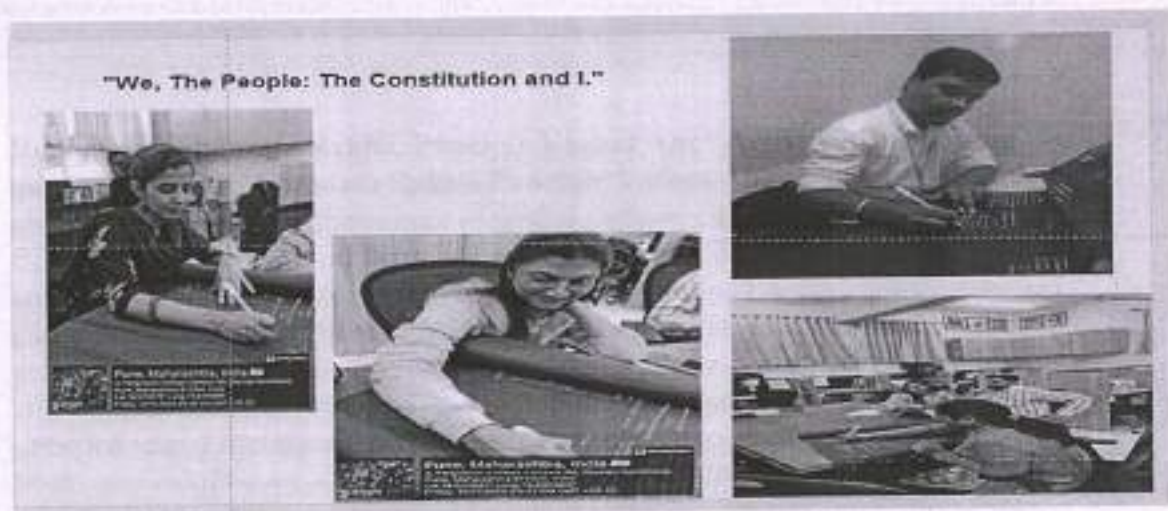


families society, and the overall well-being of the community.
